This long-awaited sixth installment in the 10-part *Footprints of God* series explores why Jesus is called the Son of David, and why that is important to understanding Him. It shows why and how the Kingdoms of both David and Solomon prefigure and anticipate the Kingdom of God and the Catholic Church. In essence, it shows how both Jewish *and* Christian roots can be traced – physically and scripturally – all the way back to the Davidic Kingdom of the Jews and of the Old Testament.

Shot entirely on location in Israel, Syria, Turkey, Greece and Italy with popular Catholic author and speaker Stephen Ray as tour guide, “David & Solomon” addresses in an exciting and fast-paced way a subject about which very little has been created in the way of film or documentary.

“David & Solomon” is 90-minutes in length, and available in both DVD and VHS format.
